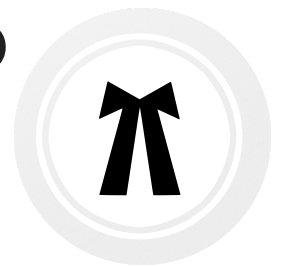
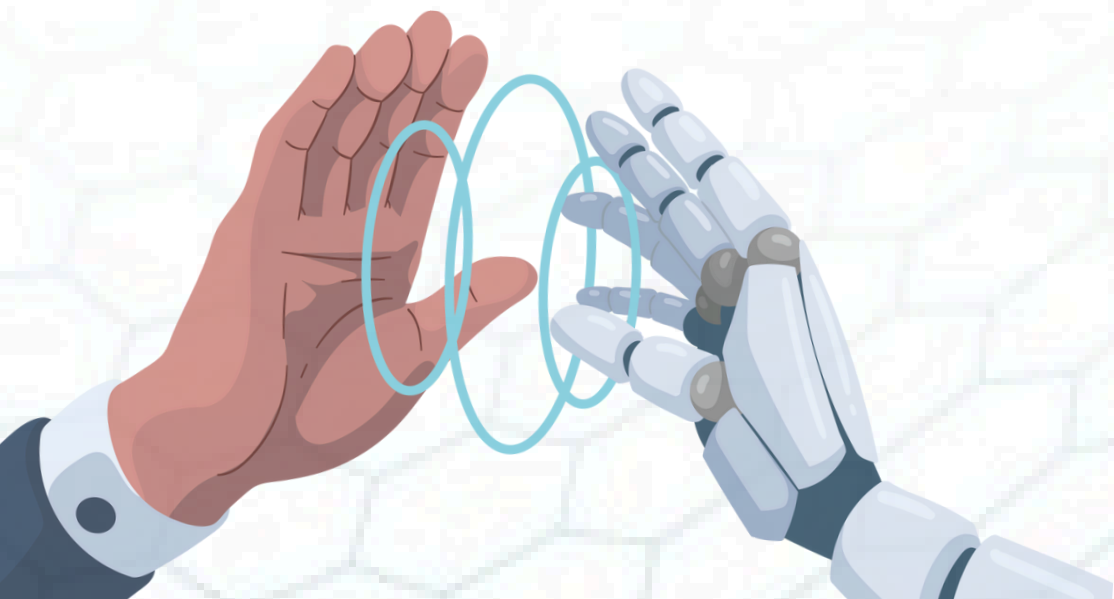

AI can supercharge your legal work, but only if you know how to talk to it.



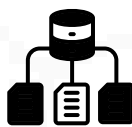
The quality of your prompt = the quality of your answer



Give Clear Instructions



Put in Context



With Structure



Break tasks into steps

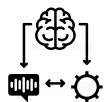
Breaking down tasks step-by-step helps the tool follow a logical sequence.



“Check the termination clause and fix any problems.”



Begin by reviewing the termination clause for clarity.



Then, identify any ambiguous language or undefined terms.



Then, propose amendments to make the clause clearer and more enforceable.



AI follows logic better



Practice good data hygiene

Clean, clearly labelled, structured content is more identifiable to AI and improves response quality.

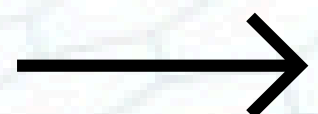
Messy file names confuse AI.

Clean, structured data = Better Results



Say it positively

Models respond better to positive reinforcement, negative instructions can confuse.



“Do not include any references to liability in the indemnity clause.”



“Ensure that the indemnity clause focuses solely on protecting against third-party claims and does not include liability provisions.”



Positive > Negative instructions.



Be precise in your instructions

Legal language requires precision; more specific instructions = more accurate outputs.



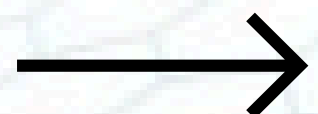
“Draft a confidentiality clause.”



“Draft a clause for a SaaS contract covering trade secrets, customer data, enforceable for 5 years. excluding publicly available data. Ensure non-disclosure for 5 years post-termination and outline penalties for breach”



Precision = Accuracy.



Add context

Context helps the model understand the broader landscape and give relevant responses.



“...draft a liability clause that limits the vendor’s responsibility for service downtime.”



“In the context of a software-as-a-service (SaaS) agreement, draft a liability clause that limits the vendor’s responsibility for service downtime.”



Context = Relevance.



Repeat key instructions at the start and end

Reinforces tasks, prevents missed details, and keeps focus throughout the process.



“Please draft a comprehensive indemnification clause that protects against third-party claims related to negligence.”

...and repeat at the end:



“Make sure the indemnification clause includes protection against third-party claims related to negligence.”

▶ **Start and end with what matters most.**



Keep the length of data or information manageable

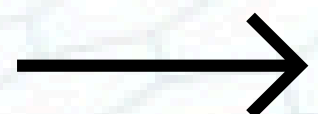
Don't dump huge volume of data in one go.

Break into smaller sections / chunks.

Prevents the tool from being overwhelmed with too much information.



AI handles bite-sized chunks better.



Use Past Examples

Referencing examples or standards guides AI toward tailored outputs



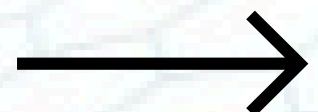
Please add a confidentiality clause.”

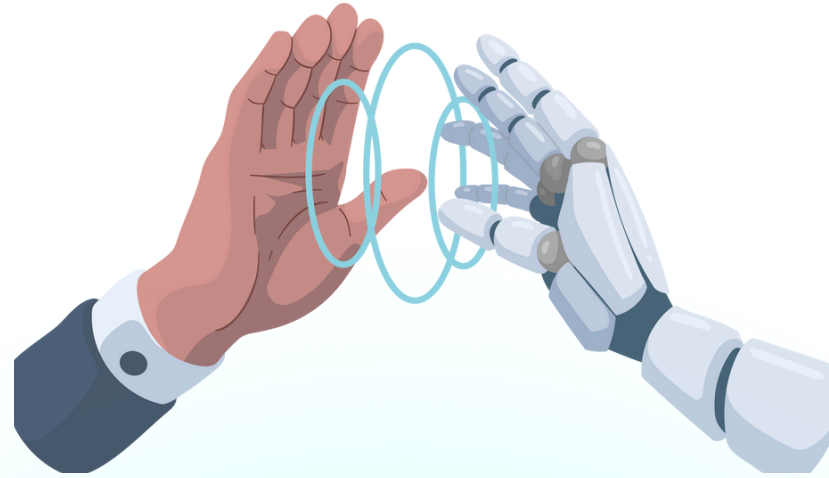


“Draft a confidentiality clause similar to Section 4 of our standard NDA, adjusted for employment contracts.”
